On the Horizon:

Q&A with Team Clagett's Team Leader Bradley Johnson



Team Clagett will debut as a means of providing selected Clagett sailors the opportunity to experience training and racing at National and World Championship sailing events.

The first Team Clagett event will be the 2.4mR World Championship held at Davis Island Yacht Club in Tampa, Florida USA in November of 2022. Four selected Clagett sailors will form Team Clagett.

Bradley Johnson is a three time Paralympian and former Clagett Sailor. Bradley, with his vast experience at World Championship level events, is the 2022 Team Clagett Team Leader.

Q: What makes Team Clagett an especially interesting program to you?

A: The interesting aspect of the program that few may know, is that the desire to provide an avenue to sail for individuals with physical challenges was spawned by Tom Clagett after his personal experience with Meningitis and sharing his thoughts regarding his temporary paralysis; and the permanent paralysis of others. Unbeknownst to Tom, his daughter and granddaughter would see that his vision came to fruition.

Q: What difference does this kind of support at the Championship level make?

A: The financial Support provided at the championship level affords the athlete the time to focus on their sailing skills; and for many, championship entry fees, new sails, coaching, and dock support, are financial impossibilities. (I anticipate that the combination of Clagett Sailing's generosity, and the talent of Team Clagett members, will yield top finishing positions.

Q: What is your advice to the members of Team Clagett?

A: Practice a multiplicity of start line/timed approaches, because you might get caught outside your comfort zone. Hence, get comfortable from every position behind the start line.

Get on the water and sail the course area prior to the committee boat leaving the dock to check and record the course conditions to monitor for changes prior to and during the race.

Eat a light pre-race meal and carry whatever energy snack you enjoy with you while racing.

In the Sonar fleet, longtime Clagett sailor Sarah Everhart Skeels and her crew of Pauline Dowell and Emma Montgomery, who both hail from Massachusetts, won the class after six races. The allfemale crew also won the overall C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta trophy. Thank you to all of the donors, sponsors, volunteers, supporters and friends that made the 2021 C. convictions and lived by his principles. Those close to him, and even some not so close, never were left in doubt of where he stood on any given issue that was important to him.
