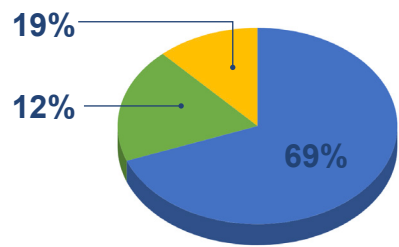

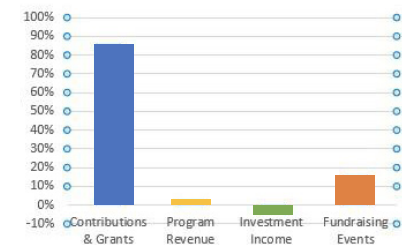

Clagett Newport, The 2022 C. Thomas Clagett Jr. Memorial Regatta

2022 was a milestone year for the C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta as it celebrated 20 years of providing opportunities to sailors with disabilities which lead to the rebranding of the organization to Clagett Sailing. Adding to the Reach for Success motto of Tom Clagett - "Reach for Success!" with the mantra "Learn, Race and Win.": Learn...to • Race...in the Corinthian Spirit • Win...self-empowerment, Clagett Sailing looks forward to the next 20 years of providing opportunities and access to programs to sailors with disabilities. Clagett Regatta had thirty two sailors from across North America and the Caribbean, competing at the 20th Anniversary C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta which started with five boats in 2003.

26 boats competed in two classes representing 10 US states and territories and three Canadian provinces. Puerto Rico's Julio Reguero took home both the C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Trophy and first place in the 2.4mR class. Taking his third title in the double handed Martin 16 class at a Clagett Regatta was Californian skipper Carwile LeRoy and his crew Tannis Hall from Canada.

The members of Clagett's own Team Clagett, a group of five sailors who competed in the 2022 2.4mR World Championships in Tampa Florida, were selected as a result of their finishing place in the 2.4mR class.

Team Clagett competes at the 2.4mR Worlds in Florida

2022 was the inaugural year of Team Clagett representing Clagett Sailing. The team was selected at the Clagett Regatta in Newport, with the top five sailors with disabilities in the 2.4mR class being named to compete under the colors of Clagett Sailing at the 2022 2.4mR World Championship which



was hosted by the Davis Island Yacht Club in Tampa, Florida in November. Representing Team Clagett was Julio Reguero, San Juan, Puerto Rico, Charlie Rosenfield, Woodstock, Conn., Peter Eager, Toronto, Ontario, Canada, Delani Hulme-Lawrence, Saint Paul, Alberta, Canada, and Chris Childers, San Francisco, CA.

Team Clagett member and Clagett Boat Grantee, Delani Hulme Lawrence received the Top Youth award for the Open Worlds in a fleet of 41 boats representing nine countries. A formidable showing by all of Team Clagett who were supported by Team Manager and Clagett Sailing Alumni and Paralympic sailor Brad Johnson along with Coach Marek Valasek, who has coached adaptive sailors since 2001. In 2022 Team Clagett was sponsored by Quantum Sails.

Clagett Boat Grant Program: 2022 Chris Childers

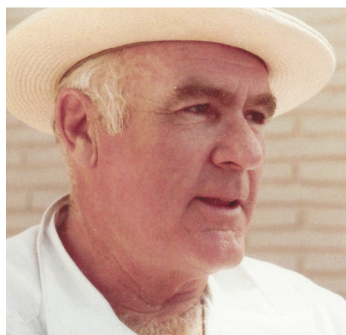
Chris Childers was a Clagett Boat Grant recipient in 2022.

Chris has significant sailing and racing experience in para- and adaptive-sailing boats. He has competed in several national disabled regattas.



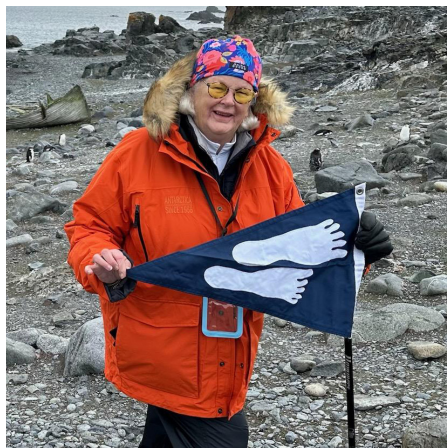

The Man who Inspired the Mission: C. Thomas Clagett, Jr.



The Clagett Regatta honors the memory of Tom Clagett, born in Washington, D.C. who initially learned to sail on the Chesapeake Bay. In his youth Tom came down with meningitis which left him paralyzed. The condition was temporary but it left him with a respect and appreciation for the accomplishments that disabled persons are able to achieve. Tom was a man who had strong convictions and lived by his principles.

The Origin of The Clagett Sailing Burgee design by Judy McLennan



So many have asked the origins of Clagett Sailing's Burgee.

A burgee is a flag with a unique design that yachts fly to make it easier to identify the owner or the Yacht Club that the owner belongs to.

Nancy Leiter designed her Burgee to be a yellow rectangle with a green ladder. Ladder being the English translation from her German last name

"Leiter". When Nancy married Tom Clagett, Tom thought he could race under Nancy's Burgee until he was told in no uncertain terms by Nancy that he needed to design his own.

Nancy was not one who enjoyed wearing shoes and would prefer to go barefoot. Nancy and Tom's first boat together was named The Barefoot Girl. Thus, Tom decided that his Burgee would be a Navy triangle pennant with two Bare Feet.

When it came time to come up with a logo design for the Clagett it seemed very natural that Tom Clagett's Burgee would become part of the overall design.
