Clagett Sailing family stayed on course as we tacked and jibed our way through the high and low waves in 2023. A big thank you to everyone who has stayed with us through the 20 + years of Clagett Sailing.

We will continue moving forward in honor of my Grandfather and Mother, as we continue to grow and fulfill the Clagett Sailing Mission and Vision, by assembling the best Coaches and Race Committees for the Clagett Sailors across all our events and to whom we owe a great deal of gratitude.

We awarded five Team Clagett scholarships to sailors, both current and former Boat Grant recipients, who made up Team USA and traveled to the Netherlands for the World Championships in the Hansa 303 and the 2.4mR classes. We are very proud that long time Clagett coach Betsy Alison, who sailed in the Hansa 303 Women's division took home the gold and World Champion title, congratulations Betsy.

We have continued our Boat Grant Program and awarded three new boat grants in 2023.

We were able to host the fleet racing in Newport, RI and match racing in Oyster Bay, NY with our partners Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club and Oakcliff Sailing Center.

We have continued to partner with Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford, MD. They invited the 2.4mR class to sail in the spring and fall regattas and the sailors are turning out in large numbers. The CAN AM series has proven to be incredibly popular with Clagett sailors as they enjoy racing in Florida during the winter before heading north for the summer racing schedule.

We also had a team of Clagett supporters who ran and walked over the Pell Bridge in the 12th Pell Bridge Run.

I want to thank the Board of Clagett Sailing, the Advisory Committee, Working Committee, Volunteers, Donors, Supporters who all work tirelessly year round to continue promoting Clagett Sailing and to provide opportunities for sailors to Learn, Race and Win in their own way on the water or land.

In Memoriam

No matter where Judy McLennan lived, she made lifelong friends and a difference in her communities.

Judy co-founded and served as President of the C. Thomas Clagett, Jr., Memorial Clinic and Regatta for sailors with disabilities for over 20 years. The regatta is named after Judy's father, Tom, who was a U.S. Navy World War II veteran who learned to sail on the Chesapeake Bay.

Daughter of the late C. Thomas Clagett, Jr., and Nancy Leiter Clagett, Judy is survived by her daughter Stephanie McLennan, son Travis McLennan, and grandson Dominic J. McLennan and her two beloved yellow Labradors, Miss Daisy and Margot. Judy was known for her many treasured dogs who were a source of joy and love over many years and accompanied her on numerous road trips and adventures.

Judy received numerous awards and recognitions in her lifetime included the U.S. Sailing President's Award twice; once in 2003 and again twenty years later in 2023.

She was a member of the New York Yacht Club, Ida Lewis Yacht Club, Tred Avon Yacht Club, Newport Yacht Club, Clambake Club, Spouting Rock Beach Assoc., Chevy Chase Country Club, and The Metropolitan Club of Washington, D.C.

Judy was proud to be a Lifetime Associate of the Fraternal Order of Police. In her work at Blair House, the Secret Service enlisted her as a member. She delighted in sharing lunch with her fellow members. She wore her Ferragamo's and they wore tactical boots, they adored her.

Throughout her life, Judy was an influential leader in charitable and civic organizations, and her lifelong interest and participation in skiing and sailing led to her positions as a Board Member on the Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum and as a member of the U.S. Sailing Committee for Sailors with Disabilities. She was an Associate Member of the Canadian Ski Instructors Alliance and was once a co-owner of a ski school in Canada.

Each friend had his or her own special relationship to Judy. She shared her love of life with all who knew her. Her passing has left an irreplaceable hole in the hearts of those who were fortunate enough to call her their friend.



New Boat Grantees in 2023

The Boat Grant program is one of the dynamic programs offered by Clagett Sailing. This program provides selected sailors and sailing programs with a race ready boat. The granted boat provides sailors and programs the opportunity to train, and race in adaptive sailing events. The grant provides for the use of the boat and equipment for up to four years.

Clagett Sailing's Boat Grant Program is open to any North American sailor with adaptive needs with a desire to train and race, or a sailing program that has either an existing program or is looking to create a new program working with adaptive needs sailors. In 2023 Clagett Sailing welcomed three new grantees and renewed a granted program.

YKnot - The Y-Knot Sailing Program in Lake George, NY renewed their Sonar Boat Grant in 2023. The Y-Knot Sailing Program was the very first Clagett Sailing grantee and the Sonar continues to enrich the program in Lake George where the boat is used as a teaching tool. Y-Knot incorporates adaptive equipment including helm adaptations for sailors who may need a sip-and-puff steering mechanism.

Anchors Away Fundraiser



Enthusiastic supporters and friends of Clagett Sailing gathered at Ida Lewis Yacht Club on a May evening to support the Anchors Away Annual Spring Gala Fundraiser. This year the Cause Auction raised funds for Team Clagett, which was a supporter of the US Para Sailors who represented the United States at the Para World Sailing Championships, which took place at the Hague.

Each member of the US Para Worlds Team has a long-time connection to Clagett Sailing. Beginning with John Seepe – a former Clagett Boat grantee and longtime Clagett Regatta attendee, and Maureen McKinnon another longtime Clagett sailor and two-time US Paralympic sailor. Maureen also became a boat grant recipient in 2023. To add yet another connection, Shan McAdoo sailed with Maureen in the US Para Championship RS Venture Connect Class and was a SKUD 18 Champion at Clagett. Another Clagett regatta attendee, Jim Thweatt sailed in the Men's Hansa Class at the Para Worlds. And of course, Betsy Alison – a 5 time Rolex Yachtswoman of the Year, Clagett Coach and member of the Clagett Working Committee. Congratulations to Betsy who competed and won the gold medal in the Women's Hansa 303 class.

The connection between the sailors attending the US Para Worlds and Clagett Sailing is an example of the ongoing commitment Clagett Sailing has made and delivered on in the sailing community, and to sailors with disabilities. Clagett Sailing will continue its mission to provide top level inclusive competitive sailing events and opportunities.

Thirty-one sailors competed at the 21st C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta presented by Clagett Sailing which hosted the 2023 U.S. Para Sailing Championships.

The 21 sailors in the 2.4mR class and 10 sailors in the Martin 16 class completed eight races with a variety of conditions from rain to fog to sun and everything in between, in a breeze which was from a mostly southerly direction between four-10 knots.

In the larger fleet of the two classes racing this year, the 2.4mR class, the titles for the C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta and the 2023 U.S. Para Sailing Championship went to Julio Reguero who was defending his Clagett Regatta title from 2022. In second place in the 2.4mR class for the C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta and the winner of the U.S. National Para Champion and the Judd Goldman Trophy was Charlie Rosenfield. In third place in the Clagett Regatta was Tony Pocklington and in the U.S. Para Sailing Championship it was Peter Eager who took home the bronze.

Reguero, also took home the overall C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. trophy for the Clagett Regatta for the second time.

The double handed Martin 16 class with five boats racing, was won by Gary Pierce and Jeff Long in the C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta. Second in the C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta Martin 16 was Steven Safford and Albert Pierce and in third was Tim Brown and Sarah Everhart Skeels. In the U.S. Para Sailing Championships in the Martin 16 it was Tim Brown and Sarah Everhart Skeels who took home gold and Dawn Hart and Kris Scheppe who took the silver.

Clagett Sailing President and Co – Founder Judy Clagett McLennan commented prior to prize giving, “We’ve had a bit of everything with weather over the last five days and I’d like to share a comment Casey Kirwin made in the tent earlier “Nature treats everyone equally.”

The sixth Clagett/Oakcliff Match Racing Clinic and Regatta for sailors with disabilities was hosted by Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club over the weekend of August 25-27, with twelve sailors from across the US traveling to Oyster Bay, NY to participate.

Friday's clinic had great conditions for the sailors to work on the water. They were coached by the duo of Daves: America's Cup helmsman, Dave Dellenbaugh and five-time US Match Racing Champion, Dave Perry. The two coaches worked with the sailors for all three days of the event on and off the water.

Day one of racing contrasted the beautiful conditions on Friday and the sailors didn't get on the water due to the lack of wind. However, this allowed more classroom time and swapping of stories onshore.

On Sunday, the northerly breeze filled in early so the teams headed out to Cold Spring Harbor where they managed to complete a full round robin before the breeze died.

Coach Dave Perry commented after the three days in Oyster Bay, “We managed to get a full round robin in, great match racing, passes, penalties, penalties killed and no contact with spirited competition.”

First place went to Charlie Rosenfield, who has sailed at all six Clagett/Oakcliff regattas. His crew Stu Caplan has sailed five of those regattas with Charlie and they were joined by Dan Andrews for his first ever Clagett.

Duane Farrar sailed with fellow visually impaired sailor Kris Scheppe and sighted sailor Dana Robinson who sails with Farrar in Boston. Scheppe, sailed at the 21st C. Thomas Clagett Jr., Memorial Clinic and Regatta in Newport in the Martin 16 class with Dawn Hart, however this was his first Clagett/Oakcliff. Farrar has previously sailed at the Clagett Regatta in Newport when Clagett Sailing hosted the Blind Sailing Championships.



2023 was the second time at Clagett/Oakcliff match racing for Eli Workman, who sailed in 2022 with Charlie Rosenfield and returned for the sixth Clagett/Oakcliff to sail with his father Dan and James Windsor. Eli grew up sailing with his father Dan Workman in the Laser 28 and Express 37's out of their home club Jubilee Yacht Club in Beverly, Massachusetts.

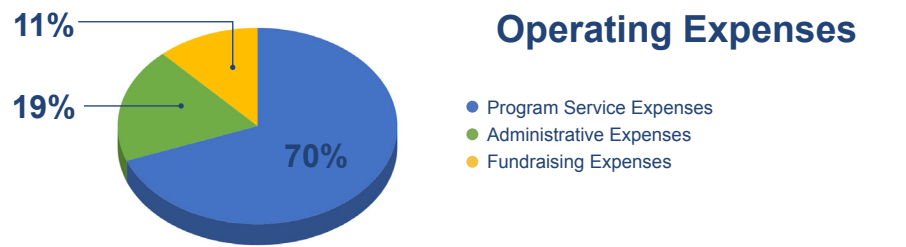

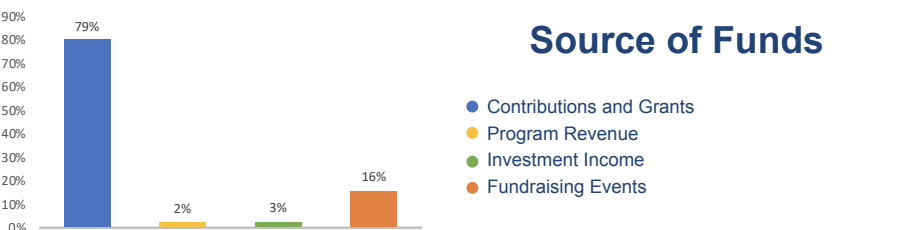
