Adaptive Sailing and our Mission

Clagett Sailing is a non-profit organization with multiple programs. It assists sailors living with disabilities to elevate their race ready sailing skills by providing adaptive sailing opportunities.

Mission:

Provide sailors with disabilities the opportunity to improve their racing skills and reach personal goals through world-class coaching and competition.

Vision:

Lead in developing competitive sailing opportunities for sailors with disabilities.

Strategy:

Provide venues and programs that include motivating information and educational instruction, that will assist sailors with disabilities to attain the competitive status they would like to reach.



2024 Events:

• Fleet Racing - Newport, R.I. June 25-30

Clagett Newport is an intensive five-day combination clinic and regatta. 2024 will be the 22nd Anniversary of Clagett Sailing. The programming is steadfast in its goal to improve the skills of sailors as they attain their individual goals both in competition and in everyday life.

• Match Racing - Oyster Bay, N.Y. August 23-25

Clagett Sailing expects to hold its annual Clagett/Oakcliff Match Race event. The goal of the event is to provide top level match race coaching and learn skills that are transferable to fleet racing and beyond.

Fleet Racing

The 2024 Clagett Newport is open to three classes of boats, the boats are owned or chartered by the sailors:

- 2.4mRs (Single-handed keelboat)
- The Martin 16 (Doubled-handed keelboat)
- Sonar (Tripled-handed keelboat)

Match Racing

During the match racing event Clagett/Oakcliff uses triple-handed Sonar keelboats courtesy of Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club. The Sonars are raced "one on one," in several roundrobin matches.

Where the Fleet Racing Event Takes Place

Newport, R.I., The "City-by-the-Sea": The backdrop for Clagett Sailing's fleet racing event is picturesque Newport Harbor. Newport has long been referred to as the "sailing capital of the world." The "City-by-the-Sea" has been the home for the America's Cup, Volvo Ocean Race, Olympic and Paralympic trials and thousands of local, national and world-class sailing regattas.

Sail Newport, R.I.'s Public Sailing Center: Regatta activities are centered at Sail Newport in Fort Adams State Park. The Sail Newport Sailing Center is Clagett Sailing's fleet racing event headquarters for the clinic, racing and social events.

Race Area: The racing generally occurs to the south of the Newport Bridge, between Rose and Goat islands.





Where the Match Racing Event Takes Place

Clagett/Oakcliff Match Racing Event

Oyster Bay, N.Y.

The Clagett/Oakcliff Match Racing event translates the mission and vision of Clagett Sailing, and provides expert coaching, competitive racing, high-performance training, development of racing strategy and improving boat handling skills – in a new venue and racing format.

Partnerships with Oakcliff Sailing, Seawanhaka Corinthian Yacht Club and Clagett's local event committee are essential to the match racing event's success.

The Clagett/Oakcliff Match Racing event takes place on Long Island Sound. The combination of small fleet size, highperformance coaching and generally light wind on Long Island Sound creates an optimum environment for learning match racing rules and boat handling skills.

The match racing event provides sailors with disabilities and some with visual impairments, like Pauline Dowell (pictured skippering) with new and challenging opportunities to "Reach for Success."

Clagett Sailing honors the late Tom Clagett (1916-2001), a U.S. Navy World War II veteran who learned to sail on the Chesapeake Bay.


As a youngster he experienced paralysis as the result of a bout of viral meningitis. The experience left him with a deep respect for the accomplishments of people living with disabilities, especially athletes. Tom's daughter Judy, granddaughter Stephanie, and with a small group of friends, co-founded Clagett Sailing in 2003 to help sailors living with accessible challenges acqire competetive racing skills.
