Adaptive Sailing and our Mission

Clagett Sailing (formerly known as The C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta) is a non-profit organization with multiple programs. It assists sailors living with disabilities to elevate their racing skills by providing adaptive sailing opportunities.

Mission:

Provide sailors with disabilities the opportunity to improve their racing skills and reach personal goals through world-class coaching and competition.

Vision:

Lead in developing competitive sailing opportunities for sailors with disabilities.

Strategy:

Provide venues and programs that include motivating information and educational instruction, that will assist sailors with disabilities to attain the competitive status they would like to reach.



2023 Events:

- **Fleet Racing - Newport, R.I.***
June 20-25

Clagett Newport is an intensive five-day combination clinic and regatta. 2023 will be the 21st Anniversary of Clagett Sailing. The programming is steadfast in its goal to improve the skills of sailors as they attain their individual goals both in competition and in everyday life.

- **Match Racing - Oyster Bay, N.Y.***
August 25-27

Clagett Sailing expects to hold its annual Clagett/Oakcliff Match Race event. The goal of the event is to provide top level match race coaching and learn skills that are transferable to fleet racing and beyond.

Where the Fleet Racing Event Takes Place

Clagett Sailing

Newport, R.I., The “City-by-the-Sea”: The backdrop for Clagett Sailing’s fleet racing event is picturesque Newport Harbor. Newport has long been referred to as the “sailing capital of the world.” The “City-by-the-Sea” has been the home for the America’s Cup, Volvo Ocean Race, Olympic and Paralympic trials and thousands of local, national and world-class sailing regattas.

Sail Newport, R.I.’s Public Sailing Center: Regatta activities are centered at Sail Newport in Fort Adams State Park. The Sail Newport Sailing Center is Clagett Sailing’s fleet racing event headquarters for the clinic, racing and social events.

Race Area: The racing generally occurs to the south of the Newport Bridge, between Rose and Goat islands.



Where the Match Racing Event Takes Place

Clagett/Oakcliff Match Racing Event*

Oyster Bay, N.Y.

The Clagett/Oakcliff Match Racing event translates the mission and vision of Clagett Sailing, and provides expert coaching, competitive racing, high-performance training, development of racing strategy and improving boat handling skills – in a new venue and racing format.

Partnerships with Oakcliff Sailing, Seawanhaka Yacht Club and Clagett's local event committee are essential to the match racing event's success.

The Clagett/Oakcliff Match Racing event takes place on Long Island Sound. The combination of small fleet size, high-performance coaching and generally light wind on Long Island Sound creates an optimum environment for learning match racing rules and boat handling skills.

The match racing event provides sailors with disabilities and some with visual impairments, like Pauline Dowell (pictured skippering) with new and challenging opportunities to “Reach for Success.”

Clagett Sailing's Mission in Action

Supply a world-class coaching team:

A team of high-performance coaches is assembled for the clinic and regatta in both Newport and Oyster Bay. Coaches include Olympic athletes, world champion sailors, all-American collegiate sailors and professional coaches.

Deliver expert race management:

The volunteer race committee includes Paralympic/Olympic certified race management professionals, as well as international, national and club-certified officials.

Provide an accessible marine facility:

Both Clagett fleet racing and Clagett match racing venues are adapted in a variety of ways to make the facilities accessible to participants. Both facilities are adapted with accessible ramps to floating docks, several lifts for sailors to board boats and ample storage areas for boats, trailers and vehicles.

Program Sponsorship

The Boat Grant Program

Clagett Sailing's Boat Grant Program was established in 2016 as a means of providing selected sailors and sailing programs the opportunity to experience, train, and race in sailing events. Since its inception, The Clagett Boat Grant Program has granted a Sonar to the Y-Knot Program in Lake George, N.Y. and eight 2.4mRs to individuals in Canada and the USA.

This sponsorship is restricted for boat grant program use and is separate from general regatta sponsorship.

Virtual Learning

In 2020 it became apparent that the in-person regattas had to be postponed to 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Clagett responded by starting the Dave and Dave Master Coaching Class Clinics, led by sailing legends Dave Perry and Dave Dellenbaugh.

Should the pandemic force the postponement of either the event in Newport or in Oyster Bay, virtual coaching will be considered as an alternative.

The goal of the virtual learning series is to provide sailors with online sessions to improve their sailing skills. Clagett has conducted three virtual clinic sessions in 2020 and 2021.

On average there were 50 attendees per virtual session. When asked if the participants would attend another Dave and Dave Master Class Series, 100% of sailors surveyed answered “yes.”

Clagett Sailing honors the late Tom Clagett (1916-2001), a U.S. Navy World War II veteran who learned to sail on the Chesapeake Bay.

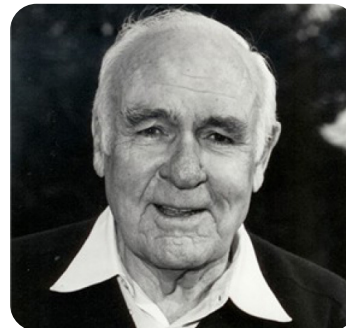

'A whole new world of freedom': Sailors with disabilities compete at an elite level

Pauline Dowell may never be able to drive a car, but she can sail a boat around the world.

Dowell is legally blind and is one of many athletes with disabilities who competes in the C. Thomas Clagett Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta, an event she has competed in since losing her sight nearly a decade ago.

Each year, dozens of athletes with disabilities participate in the twice-a-year event, which is held in both Newport, Rhode Island, and Oyster Bay, New York. The mission is to provide a space for sailors with disabilities to train and compete at an elite level, and sailors of various abilities -- ranging from paraplegia to those missing limbs to those who are blind -- are invited to show off their skills.

Top competitors emerge at U.S. Para Sailing Championships in Newport

NEWPORT — The final day of racing at the 18th C. Thomas Clagett, Jr. Memorial Clinic and Regatta and the 2021 U.S. Para Sailing Championships wrapped up Sunday for the 23 boats in the 2.4mR, Martin 16 and Sonar classes competing.

The last day for the 2021 regatta started out with a light south easterly breeze that topped at 8 knots with the current increasing during the three races for the 2.4mR and Martin 16's, who sailed in an area similar to Saturday between Rose and Goat Islands.
